Jay had attained the level of Eagle Scout in the Boy Scouts of America. He participated in this with his father who was the scout master. From high school Jay graduated with a GPA 3.781. In 1984 he graduated from MATC with Scholastic Honors with the Degree of Associate, Applied Science in Electrical Technology-Computer Science. Then in 1994 he graduated from Carroll College with a Bachelor of Science, Summa Cum Laude.

Jay worked locally for companies including Johnson Control, DCI Marketing, FIS, He had worked and lived in the Oakland / San Francisco area of California for a start-up company called Modius, and he has been self employed as a computer consultant.

Jay had a wide area of hobbies and interests. He enjoyed working on projects, tinkering, shopping rummage or garage sales, and salvage yards. He became self-taught, starting at a very young age, by taking things apart and putting them back together. As a child he also could be seen reading what was called "The Book of Knowledge", an encyclopedia. He studied an array of topic including photography, art, music, travel, mechanics, wood, and metal working among others. His quest of knowledge and love of learning can be an inspiration to us all.
