Rosalie was a pillar of the Wisconsin community for decades. She worked tirelessly to resettle and establish a school for Russian newcomers to Milwaukee in the 1970s, was on the Board of Visitors for the School of Education at her alma mater, the University of Wisconsin - Madison, and was a committed member and longtime leader of Milwaukee's Jewish Federation.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Dr. Louis and Ardell Eisenberg, her brother, Robert Eisenberg, and her beloved husband, Gerald J. Kahn, co-founder of the law firm Godfrey & Kahn. She is survived by her daughters, Nancy, Lori, and Cindy, her sons-in-law, Ernie Grunfeld and Steve Marker, her grandchildren, Rebecca (Ryan), Daniel (Samantha), Adam, and Ruby, her great-grandchildren, Ben, Sophie, Romy, Solomon, and Jonah, and her many nieces and nephews. She will remain in the hearts of her wonderful caretakers, to whom the family is forever grateful, and her closest companion, Connie, whom she loved dearly.
