David Alan Blumberg

Born in St. Paul, Minnesota, February 10, 1946 the oldest son of Myron and Shirley Blumberg. Family moved to Long Beach, California when he was very young. David had a massive stroke Sunday, August 22, 2021 and died on Friday evening August 27, 2021. He had extraordinarily great care from the doctors and nurses on the 5th Floor Neural ICU of Columbia St. Mary's Milwaukee.

Survived by his wife, Sherry Blumberg, son Joshua Blumberg and foster daughters, Chaya and Soreh Milchtein, and Malia Howell. Brother John Blumberg (Marcie) and sister Debra Blumberg of Long Beach, and sister Barbara Kluger (Larry) of Oakland, California. Further survived by many cousins, nieces and nephews.

David practiced law with his father and brother and became a family law specialist. David and Sherry married June 13, 1982. They lived in New York where he joined a law firm and then published the New York Family Law Newsletter. Josh was born adopted in 1986. David also sang in several choirs.

They moved to Milwaukee in 1999 and settled in Glendale. David substituted in the school system for awhile and then began his own specialty law practice

in Interstate and International Child Custody Jurisdiction. He also sang with the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra Chorus since 1999, and sang as a High Holy Days Cantorial Soloist in Milwaukee and Illinois. He continued to teach Biblical Hebrew for many years.

David and Sherry began fostering children in New York and continued in Milwaukee. He loved children.

He is known for his baking of challah, and other breads. He fixed the clothes of the household with his sewing machine and did many of the home repairs.

Due to COVID-19 concerns, a small private service will be held. Donations can be made to the MSO, Congregation Emanu-El B'Ne Jeshurun, or Congregation Beth Israel Ner Tamid.

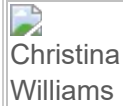
