Richard Goldberg lived a fulfilling life, always emulating the memory of his father. He was a brilliant, kind and gentle spirit who shared his love of life with everyone he encountered.

An attorney representing the trades unions with a specialty in managing benefit and pension funds, Richard was a nationally respected expert in the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) law.

Richard was an athlete, dedicating significant time and energy to being active: cycling, golfing, bowling, jogging (before it was a mainstream activity), and kayaking. He shared these experiences with those he loved. His five children gained his passion for cycling on their trips throughout Wisconsin and Europe. He enjoyed golf outings with his union buddies, and in family outings he

secured a “hole-in-one” on two occasions. In his eighties and nineties, he exercised daily, bowled with lifelong friends and golfed when his daughter and son-in-law came to visit.

A proud Jewish man, Richard spent many hours in retirement learning to write Hebrew and speak Yiddish, as well as studying the Torah with several rabbis throughout the Milwaukee area. He regularly attended morning and evening services, devoted to helping make a minion for others remembering their loved ones.

After marrying Lois, they traveled throughout Great Britain, spent winters in Naples, Florida and enjoyed 22 summer getaways on Washington Island.

He will be missed daily by Lois, his four children, two stepchildren, fifteen grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
